Introduction	The course "Business organization (disciplinary sector SECS P/10)" is one of the disciplines of the Bachelor Study "Bachelor's Degree in Business Administration from the University of Catanzaro". It will take place weekly during the first semester of the academic year 2021/2022. The Teachers will introduce 6 didactic units that will be presented following a specific agenda. The course give 9 credits and will be arrogated in 6 house of frontal lessons.

Description	The aim of the course is the understanding of the organisational phenomena related to the management of private, public and non-profit companies. The theme of organisational planning will be integrated with classical theories and analyses of the operational contexts of companies, for the students of a three-year degree program. The course will offer conceptual tools to design organisations in a complex, global and uncertain context. The course therefore aims to overcome the gap between theory and practice, comparing theory to business cases and defined problems, facilitating learning by inexperienced students.

Course Objectives and Expected Learning Outcomes (in particular: knowledge and understanding capacity; applied knowledge and understanding capacity; independent judgment; communication skills; learning ability)	The course aims to teach students: a) the development of knowledge and understanding of the needs for change in the organization of work and the planning of organizational forms of public -private-non-profit organizations, also in relation to the impact that ICT exerts on processes, operational tasks and managerial behavior. b) The development of independent judgment in the development of Organizational Assessment solutions, according to an entrepreneurial, managerial and / or consultancy logic, to specific "critical" situations exemplifying the problems of work organization and organizational planning of enterprises, public and public companies administrations. They will also be able to understand the main difficulties connected with organisational coordination activities and the different ways of pursuing them. c) the student becomes capable of formulating reflections, identifying problems and proposing solutions by resorting to an adequate and appropriate educational background. d) the development of learning skills that are useful for autonomously interpreting documents, organisational charts and reports used in organisations.
